## **GENERAL:**

Las Calderas Harbour is extensive but shallow and anchorages areas are designated by *Ciramar Shipyard* Dock Master on a case-to-case basis.

The merchant marine traffic to this harbour is limited to the *Ciramar Shipyard* customers and they keep a Pilots Cruising Ground at Lat. 18°14,0"N./Long. 70°33,8"W. Berthing operations are restricted to daylight only.

**TOWAGE:** Available requiring previous arrangement.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** Are provided using Channel 16 with the Shipyard.

**BUNKERING AND FUELING:** Fuel and Diesel oil are available by tank truck. Trucks carry up to 37.8 m3 (10,000 US gallons). Arrangements to be made in advance through **CODONAVE**.

FRESHWATER: Available at every dock.

MEDICAL FACILITIES: Full Medical Attention is available at Bani 40 km away and Santo Domingo 110 km away.

**CONSULAR OFFICES:** Santo Domingo-10 kms. Away-is the capital city of the country and most nations have some kind of representation.

**AIRPORTS:** Las Americas International Airport (SDQ), served by major international airlines, is about 160 km. away and has frequent connections to Europe, North, and South American countries and may be conveniently used for repatriation or joining of crew. This is very convenient for repair period repatriations.

## **BERTH FACILITIES:**

- Floating Dock I: Lifting Capacity 960 tons, Dry Dock Length 61.0 mts, Measurement inside wing walls 13 mts.
- Floating Dock II: Lifting Capacity 7,500 tons, Dry Dock Length 150 mts, Measurement inside wing walls 25 mts, Additional equipment Two Cranes 6 tons (each).
- Floating PIER (PONTOON): Dry Dock Length 150 mts, Measurement inside wing walls 25 mts.
