RESTRICTIONS: No entry or departure at night.

TOWAGE: Not available on site.

ANCHORAGE PROCEDURES GENERAL: A deep water anchorage is available immediately outside the pier. The pilot will indicate the best location in accordance with DR Navy Patrol Boat.

PILOTAGE: The pilot and Harbour Master can be contacted on VHF Channel 16. The pilot boards about 2 miles off the pier. Accurate ETA is important as pilot must come from Barahona 135 km. away.

WATER DENSITY: Saltwater (1,025 kg/m3).

WORKING HOURS: Around the Clock.

LOCAL HOLIDAYS: There are twelve nationwide holidays: Jan 1 (New Year's Day) Fixed, Jan 6 (Religious), Jan 21 (Religious) Fixed, Jan 26 (Duarte's Day), Feb 27 (Independence Day) Fixed, Apr. 15 (Holly Friday) Fixed, May 1 (Labor Day), Jun 16 (Religious) Fixed, Aug 16 (Restauracion Day) Fixed, Sept 24 (Religious) Fixed, Nov 06 (Constitution Day) Fixed, Dec 25 (Christmas Day) Fixed.

BUNKERING AND FUELING: Fuel and Diesel oil are available by tank truck. Trucks carry up to 37.8 m³ (10,000 US gallons). Arrangements to be made in advance through **CODONAVE**.

FRESHWATER: Supplied by tank truck or pier pipeline when available. Arrangements are to be made in advance through the Agency.

STORES AND PROVISIONS: Not available.

WASTE: Not available.

REPAIRS: Not available.

SURVEYORS: Available.

MEDICAL FACILITIES: Only emergency and minor care is available locally. Closest Hospital is at Barahona, 135 kms. away. More serious cases must be treated in Santo Domingo-300 km. away- where full hospitalization facilities are available.

CONSULAR OFFICES: All consular affairs for this port are handled at Santo Domingo.

AIRPORTS: *Las Americas International Airport (SDQ)*, served by major international airlines, is about 330 km. away and has frequent connections to Europe, North, and South American countries and may be conveniently used for repatriation or joining of crew.

BERTH FACILITIES:

Berth: About 100 m. long and the apron is about 8 m. wide. There are two mooring dolphins which allow vessels of up to 210 m. (700 ft.) LOA to dock safely alongside.
